



RE: SDS for Floorcoverings

We are in receipt of your request for a Safety Data Sheet (SDS). As defined by the Federal Hazard Communications Standard (29 CFR 1910-1200), floorcovering is considered an "article" and, as such, an SDS is not required per 29 CFR 1910-1200(b)(6). Please note the definition of an "article" includes that the manufactured item does not pose a physical hazard or health risk to employees. In addition, floorcovering is a consumer product and when used as intended, does not pose a hazard to the end user.

For Green Building certifications like LEED, WELL, etc., the path to Indoor Air/Environmental Quality credits is CRI Green Label Plus certification for carpet and FloorScore certification for hard surface flooring. All Mannington Commercial products carry this applicable certification.
