Through our work with Carpet America Recovery Effort (CARE) and Build Reuse, we can connect customers to solutions that recover more products, which diverts them from landfills and returns more material to recycled use.

The embodied carbon reduction comes from the use of recycled content in product, but that requires the manufacturer to include it.

How Does the Reclamation Process Work?

When working with customers interested in reclamation of currently installed product, our sales team uses a two-step process to anticipate the costs and efforts involved and determine the route for reclaiming product.

Step 1: Initial Information Collection

When you contact your sales representative about reclamation, our team will:

- Identify carpet manufacturer (Mannington or other)
- Assess carpet condition and potential for reuse.
- If the product is reusable, take pictures.
- Determine quantity for reclamation.
- Specify who will uninstall, palletize, and transport to a dock.
- Confirm customer willingness to pay for shipping if required.
- Establish the project timeline.

Step 2: Identifying the Reclamation Route

Once we have the information about the reclamation project, we determine the route by asking a few simple questions.
